KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Cokie Roberts is the Chief Congressional Analyst for ABC News and co-anchor of "This Week with Sam Donaldson & Cokie Roberts." She covers politics, Congress and public policy for ABC News, reporting for "World News Tonight" and other ABC News broadcasts.



Additionally, Ms. Roberts serves as a news analyst for National Public Radio, where she was the congressional correspondent for more than ten years. During that time, she won numerous awards, including the Edward R. Murrow Award—the highest honor in public radio. She was also the first broadcast journalist to win the highly prestigious Everett McKinley Dirksen Award for coverage of Congress.

Ms. Roberts is also the author of the national best seller, "We Are Our Mother's Daughters." Published in 1998, the book explores the diverse roles women have played throughout American history and the connection and distinctions among different generations of women.

She has received numerous broadcast awards for her work including a 1991 Emmy for her contribution to the ABC News Special, "Who is Ross Perot?" and the 1987 Weintal Award for her coverage of the Iran/Contra affair for PBS-TV's "MacNeil/Lehrer Newshour."

Along with her husband, Steven V. Roberts, a professor at George Washington University, Ms. Roberts writes a weekly column syndicated by United Media in major newspapers around the country. Her Op-Ed columns have appeared in the New York Times and The Washington Post.

Prior to joining NPR, Ms. Roberts was a reporter for CBS News in Athens, Greece. She also produced and hosted a public affairs program on WRC-TV in Washington, DC.

From 1981 to 1984, in addition to her work at NPR, Ms. Roberts co-hosted "The Lawmakers," a weekly public television program on congress.

A 1964 graduate of Wellesley College, Ms. Roberts has a degree in political science. In 1985 she received the Distinguished Alumnae Achievement Award in recognition of "excellence and distinction in professional pursuits." She is also the recipient of 12 honorary degrees.

A former President of the Radio and Television Correspondent's Association, Ms. Roberts and her husband are the parents of two adult children.
