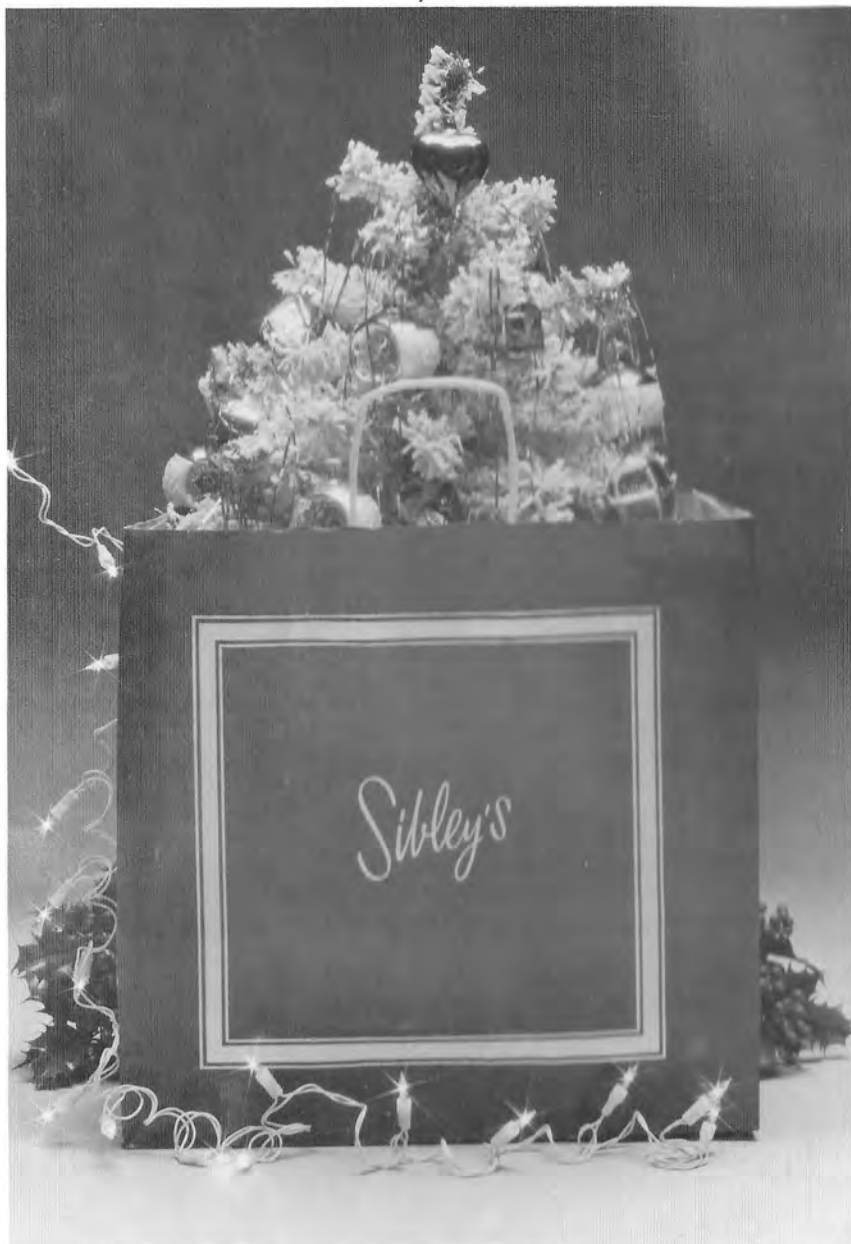

*GeVa Theatre maintains the right to reserve house seats at its discretion.*

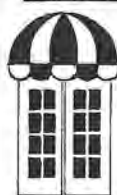
*The taking of photographs or operation of any recording device in this theatre is strictly forbidden.*

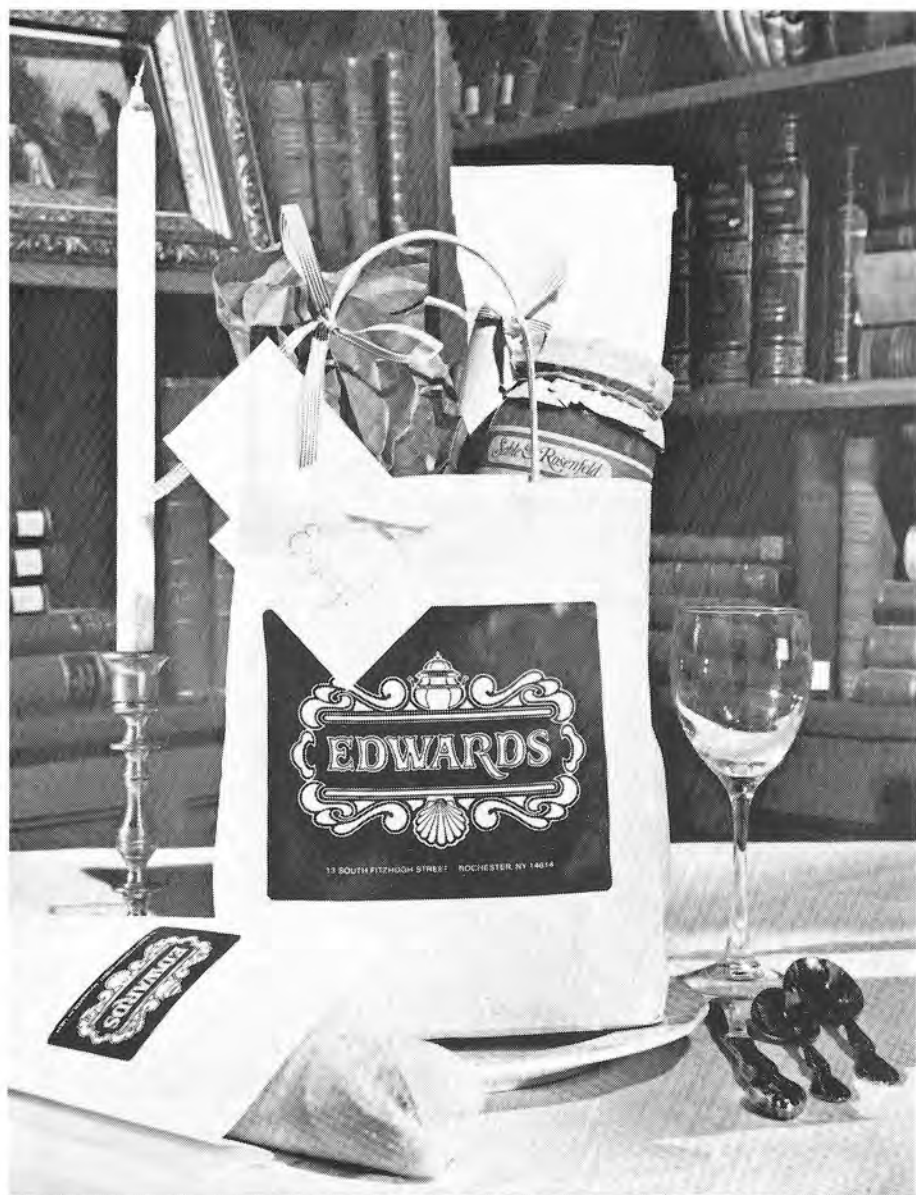
