

BE SAFE AT HOME With The KODAK GANG



Always pick up your toys when you are done playing, so no one trips and falls.




What should you do with your toys right after you are done playing with them?

Pick them up Leave them out to play with them again Wait until you are asked to pick them up House plants may look pretty but should not be eaten.




What can make you sick if you eat them?

Vegetables Chicken House plants Woodstoves and fireplaces can become hot enough to burn you, if you touch them.




What can burn you if you touch it?

Up high or in a locked cupboard Under the sink In a drawer All handles for pots and pans on the stove, should be turned in.






Soap and water make bath tubs slippery. Make sure your tub has a mat or non-skid surface so you don't fall.

Night lights help you see your way in the dark.




