

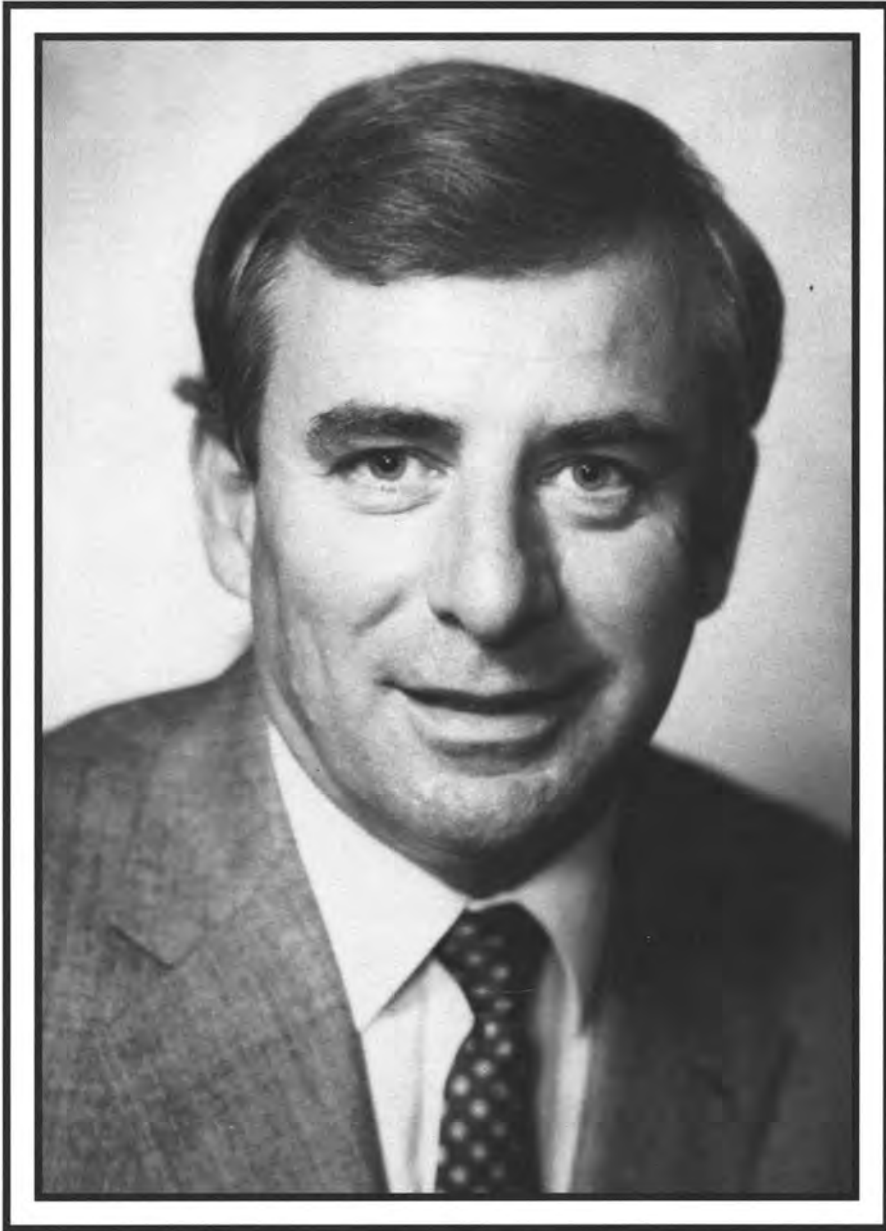




TO THE VOTECH GRADUATES OF 1991:

The VoPro program offers vocational education programs at the Vocational Technical Center for approximately 600 students each year. Generally, VoPro provides courses which are too expensive or specialized for individual districts to offer.

Through the VoPro program, students develop the skills necessary to find and hold employment. VoPro prepares graduates for employment, college study, apprenticeship, or the Armed Forces.

A recent survey showed that 99% of Monroe #1 VoPro Graduates are employed (52%) or continuing their education (42%), and have the skills to make good money to pay for that education. Five percent are in military service.

After three years in the field, 94% of Monroe #1 VoPro graduates feel that their VoPro class was helpful in their present job and 68% are working in a career related to their vocational training.

Vocational graduates are unemployed less and for briefer periods than other high school graduates.

High school students and adults attend 2-2 1/2 hour daily sessions at the Vocational Technical Center in Fairport. High school students return to their home schools and attend classes there for the rest of the day.

VoPro classroom facilities feature up-to-date equipment. The curriculum is continually updated with the help of community advisory committees made up of representatives from local business and industry.

Students learn through actual work experiences. Food Trades students, for example, run a restaurant and Cosmetology students operate a beauty salon. Auto Body students run a repair shop, while Child Care students conduct a nursery school.

Student leadership is encouraged through clubs such as VICA (Vocational Industrial Clubs of America) and DECA (Distributive Education Clubs of America).

Each year, VoPro students win a variety of awards and scholarships. They traditionally do well at statewide competitions.

Vocational Technical Center facilities are an extension of each district's high school program. Each component district has helped pay for this program. This part of a high school student's program is housed in a separate building only because it is more economical to do so. High schoolers are still full-time students in their home schools, while taking advantage of a cooperative program their schools offer.
