## Formation of the Villages of Monroe County



- Brighton** Incorporated as a Village in the Town of Brighton in 1885. Annexed by the City of Rochester in 1905.
- Brockport** In the Town of Sweden. Incorporated as a Village, Apr. 26, 1829.
- Charlotte** Incorporated as a Village in the Town of Greece, June 24, 1869. Annexed by the City of Rochester in 1916.
- Churchville** In the Town of Riga. Incorporated as a Village, March 7, 1855.

- Fairport** In the Town of Perinton. Incorporated as a Village, April 12, 1867.

- Hilton** In the Town of Parma. Incorporated as the Village of North Parma, July 28, 1885. Name changed to Hilton, April 17, 1896.
- Honeoye Falls** In the Town of Mendon. Incorporated as a Village, April 12, 1833.
- Pittsford** In the Town of Pittsford. Incorporated as a Village, April 7, 1827.
- Rochester** Incorporated as the Village of Rochesterville, March 21, 1817. Name changed to Rochester, April 12, 1822. Incorporated as a City, April 28, 1834 and has been enlarged many times since then.
- Scottsville** In the Town of Wheatland. Incorporated as a Village, Oct. 16, 1914.
- Spencerport** In the Town of Ogden. Incorporated as a Village, April 22, 1867.
- Webster** In the Town of Webster. Incorporated as a Village, April 26, 1905.
